# Post 435 Service Rifle Clinic

## CMP Approved Match

---

**DATE:** Saturday 6 JUNE, 2026  
RAIN OR SHINE. Dress for the weather!

**LOCATION:** Our range facility is located south of the Twin Cities just off I35 see map (following page).

**TIME:** The classroom portion of the clinic will start at 08:00, plan on being at the range by 07:45. Squadding for the match and the shooting portion of the clinic will begun at 09:30, first shot downrange will be aprox. 10:00.

**SQUADDING:** At the range, Tell us if you're with someone.

**FEES:** \$40.00 Paid in advance or \$45 after June 3rd. The Clinic and Match is Limited to the first 24 competitors. You are reserving a space with your payment, notice of any cancelations must be received by Wednesday May 31st or **THERE WILL BE NO REFUND.**

**RIFLES:** Any U.S. or foreign Service Rifle capable of holding 5 rounds. The Club has loner M1 and AR15 rifles that may be used. If you'd like to use one of our rifles, please notify us upon registration. At this time we have a few issues of .30.06 ammo (60 rounds) for \$60.00 each. If you wish to use one of our M1's you will need either our ammo or a minimum of 55 rounds of CURRENT MANUFACTURE NON-CORROSIVE 30-06 AMMUNITION. We will also have commercial .223 ammunition available for the AR15's (Contact us for price).

**TARGETS:** Official NRA SR, 200 yard target.

**COURSE OF FIRE:**

- Sighting period: 5 minutes for 5 sighting shots from any position.
- Match 1: 20 shots for record Slow Fire Prone in 20 minutes.
- Match 2: 10 shots for record Standing to Prone, Rapid fire in 70 seconds.
- Match 3: 10 shots for record Standing to Sitting, Rapid fire in 60 seconds.
- Match 4: 10 shots for record Slow Fire Standing in 10 minutes.
- Match 5: An aggregate of matches 1 through 4.

**RULES:** CMP Highpower rules govern, Match Director HAS FINAL SAY .

**DUTIES:** Competitors will be required to perform Pit Duty and Score for other shooters.

**MISC.:** The club has an outhouse, water and soft drinks but no food. BRING A LUNCH OR SNACK WITH YOU .

**COMPETITORS:** Open to anyone who want's to learn how to shoot a Service Rifle in a fun, safe environment.

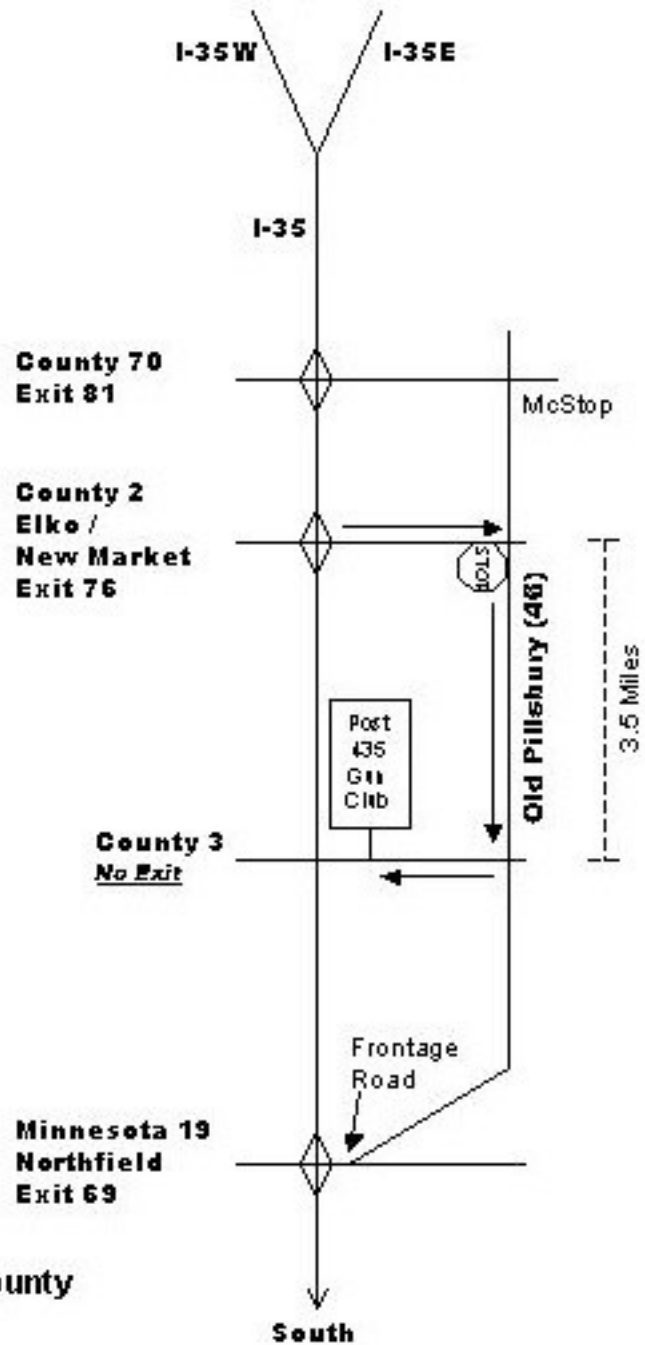

**Driving Directions from The Twin Cities:**

- Interstate 35 South to Exit 76, County Road 2 (Elko / New Market)
- Turn Left (East) from exit ramp onto County Road 2 and proceed to Stop Sign at Old Pillsbury (County Road 46).
- Turn Right (South) on Old Pillsbury and drive 3.5 Miles to County Road 3. Watch for our Club Sign on the Right, 200 Yards before County Road 3.
- Turn Right (West) on County Road 3 and watch for our Club Sign and entrance about 300 yards on Right Side. NOTE: If you cross over I-35, you have gone too far!
- Follow Gravel Driveway to Gun Club. Drive slowly and watch for deer.

**Driving Directions from Owatonna:**

- Interstate 35 North to Exit 69, "Northfield, MN HWY 19"
- Turn Right (East) from exit ramp then immediately turn Left (North) onto Service Road (Hazelwood Rd., County Road 46).
- Proceed North on Hazelwood (46) for 3.6 Miles, then turn Left (West) on County Road 3. Watch for our Club Sign and entrance about 300 yards on Right Side. NOTE: If you cross over I-35, you have gone too far!
- Follow Gravel Driveway to Gun Club. Drive slowly and watch for deer.
